Continue to Lead in Green Logistics

In 2023, Alliance introduced Hong Kong's first electric mixer truck for a one-year pilot, showcasing the potential of electric heavy-duty vehicles. The company also adopted electric vans for onsite testing and technical support. Building on this success, Alliance recently launched a hybrid mixer truck featuring an electric-powered drum paired with a diesel-powered chassis, a smart blend of efficiency and practicality.

In October 2025, Alliance became **the first fleet in Hong Kong to use Shell's Renewable Diesel R33**, a fuel with up to 33% renewable content that meets EN590 standards and cuts CO₂e emissions by up to 30%. Learn more about Diesel R33 on our [website](#).

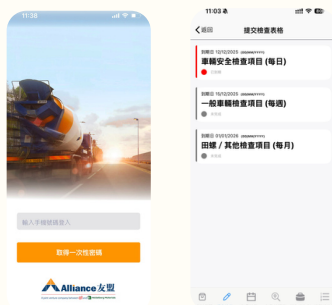

Smart Solutions for Safer Driving

Alliance is elevating Health, Safety, and Environment standards with new features in our Driver App. These enhancements help reduce risks and foster a culture of safety, responsibility, and continuous learning. Key changes include:

- **Mandatory Inspection Checklists** : Drivers must complete daily, weekly, and monthly truck inspections before sign-in to ensure vehicles are road-ready and compliant.
- **Interactive Quiz Module** : Monthly randomized questions on safety, operations, and environmental practices; full marks required before dispatch.



Delivering Excellence Beyond Concrete: On-Time Supply for Massive Bored Pile

In December 2025, Alliance successfully delivered 1,250m³ of concrete for Sunley Engineering at the Tin Wah Road Phase 1 Public Housing Foundation project, meeting all targets despite tough conditions.

- ✓ Pre-pour meetings to identify bottlenecks and set contingency plans
- ✓ Real-time communication across Production, Logistics, Technical, and CS teams
- ✓ Mobilized all 3 plants in Tsing Yi to have first load delivered by 06:45
- ✓ Precise delivery monitoring by GPS-enabled E-docket tracking
- ✓ Extra on-site technical support for concrete workability and concrete testing

Challenges

- **Tight Supply Window:** Concreting had to complete before 19:00 while extracting 12 casings
- **Logistics Challenge :** A 30 km delivery route with a high risk of traffic congestion

Result: **All concreting completed on time** - Showcasing Alliance's ability to plan strategically and deliver under pressure.



Alliance Completes First Government Design & Build Project

Highlights

- 1st Design & Build project for the Government
- Special round design with forklift-compatible holes

Recently, Alliance successfully completed its first Design and Build project for the Government, serving the Hong Kong Police Force. The scope included designing, casting, and supplying 18 concrete planter barriers within one month, despite severe weather conditions such as typhoons and black rainstorms.

The barriers feature a round design with forklift-compatible holes for easy relocation and will be used during festival events to protect pedestrians from potential vehicle collisions, reinforcing public safety. This achievement highlights Alliance's ability to innovate under pressure and reinforces our commitment to community safety and sustainable development.





Stronger & Safer: Our Cybersecurity Journey in 2025

To protect Alliance from evolving cyber threats and ensure business continuity, we strengthened our security posture through targeted initiatives. In 2025, we delivered three cybersecurity training sessions to reinforce best practices in email safety, password hygiene, and data protection. We also launched a Phishing Simulation Programme, achieving a consistently low and improving click rate. Operational measures included day-one awareness training for new joiners, USB storage controls to reduce data leakage risks, and a “Safety & Security— No Compromise” poster campaign to keep security top-of-mind. Together, these efforts make cybersecurity a shared responsibility across the company.
